 - As of now we do have one applicant for the District Manager Position.
 - Our Jetting Machine has a leak in the pump and a quote we received for a replacement is \$12,000 and is five weeks out. Ours is still functional but at any moment it may not be so

- the purchase was authorized and should be getting it in the next five weeks.
- Have received calls from McDonalds regarding their bill and they are interested in getting a second meter installed for irrigation purposes but we are working on determining if they will need to pay more capacity fees.
- Have not received any new information regarding the Prop 68 Grants for the Pool and Parks. They did a site inspection on July 9th.
- Right now the crew is demobilizing Well 9 at Washburn to put the test Well in.
- Phase 2 of the Collection System Project is 90% completed for the Plans and Specs. We should be getting the green light soon and believe we will begin construction in 2022.
- We are one signature away from receiving funding for the Meter Replacement Project. We will be replacing the west side of town first which is routes one and two.
- Waiting to hear if the State is going to put restrictions in place due to the drought. Until then we will not be putting any water restrictions in place.
- There is a new developer that is interested in putting two small buildings on the East Side of Grocery Outlet, one is an Auto Parts store and they haven't said what the other will be.
