Dear Lifeguard Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in working at the Raymond Berry Intermountain Pool. Applications are due by 4:30 p.m. on April 14th to the Burney Water District Office, Located at 20222 Hudson Street, Burney, CA 96013. Applications received after this time will not be considered for employment

After the interview process, there is a mandatory pre-employment drug screening. (provided by the Burney Water District), and if 18 or older, you may be fingerprinted prior to the Lifeguarding Training Course if not a returning employee.

Once you have successfully completed the interview and drug screening process, you may then be invited to participate in the Lifeguarding training course. A \$175.00 per person fee will need to be paid in advance and proof that you are at least 15 years old or will be by the first date of the Lifeguard Course (driver's license, state identification card, birth certificate, passport, or other government-issued photo identification) on or before 8:00 a.m. on the first day of the course.

The tentative training course schedule will be in late May or early June.

The training course will be held at the Raymond Berry Intermountain Pool, Located at 37482 Bailey Ave., Burney, CA 96013.

On the first day of the Lifeguard Course you must successfully complete the Pre-course Session (during the first class session) to continue with the Lifeguarding course. The Pre-course Session includes an evaluation of your in-water swimming skills. ***If you do not pass the skills evaluation, you will not be able to continue with the course, you will not be offered employment and will not be eligible to receive a refund.***

Items you must bring the following to all training course sessions: Lifeguarding Instructor's Manual (will be provided on the first day of class), Swimsuit/Towel, Warm Clothes, Notepaper, Pens & Highlighters, Lunch and Snacks.

To successfully complete the course, you must be in attendance during the entire course, actively participate in all skill sessions/drills, activities and scenarios, demonstrate competency in all required skills and scenarios, and pass the final written exams with a minimum grade of 80 percent.
