CANCELLATION OF BOIL WATER ADVISORY

July 25, 2023

On July 12, 2023, you were notified of the need to boil all tap water used for drinking and cooking purposes.

The Burney Water District Water System in conjunction with the State Water Resources Control Board's Division of Drinking Water has determined that, after disinfection of the entire water system, extensive flushing, and comprehensive testing of the water, your water is safe to drink. **It is no longer necessary to boil your tap water or for you to consume bottled water.**
